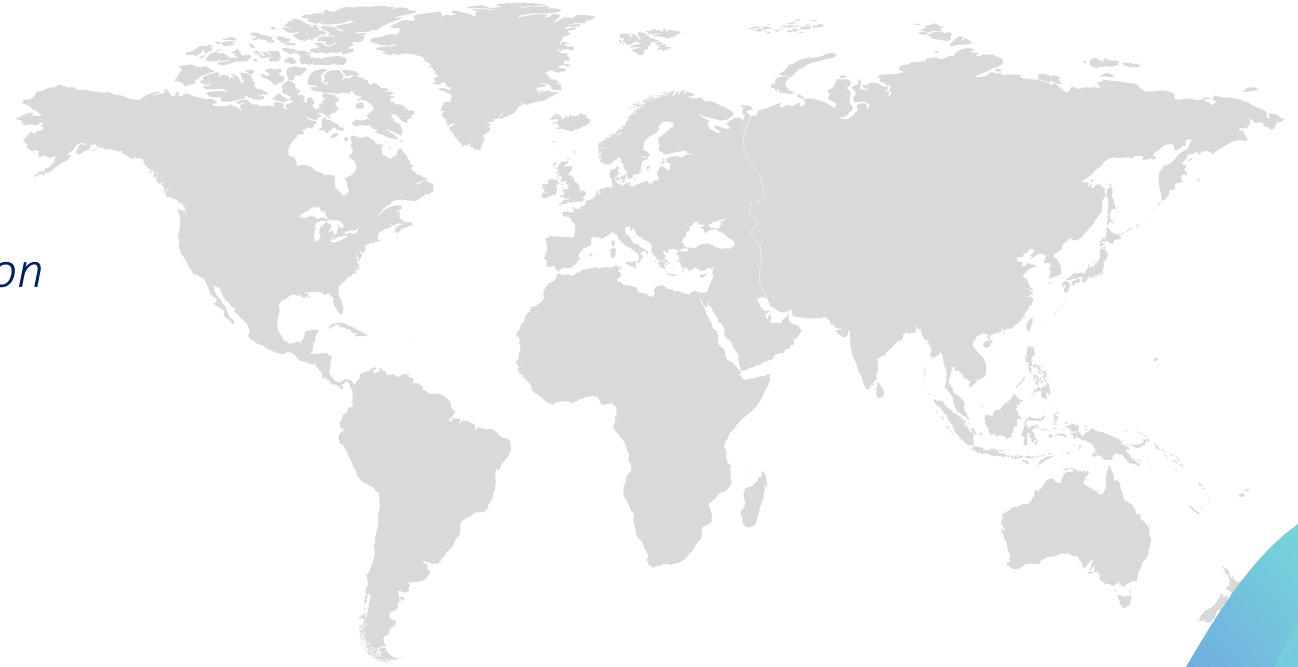
Webinar Description
